LONG known for its heritage-listed buildings and factory outlet stores, Collingwood has emerged in recent years as an arts precinct. This weekend an inaugural walking tour will take in all the area has to offer – from the famed Port Jackson Press to indigenous watercolours at Mossenson Galleries, from Erwin Fabian's sculptures at Australian Galleries to Filomena Coppola's works on paper at Dickerson (her *Soul fire* is pictured below). Beginning with morning tea at Catherine Asquith Gallery, 48 Oxford Street, participants will be escorted to each gallery on a progressive afternoon tour. Refreshments, artist and gallery director talks and lectures will be held along the way. The four-hour tour will take place within a 500-metre/two-block radius.
